APPOINTMENT OF EMERITUS PROFESSORS

1. Senate, with the approval of Council, may confer the title of Emeritus Professor on a professor at the time of retirement or, should there be a superannuation contract, at the end of the contract when the professor leaves the full-time service of the University.
2. The professor must have held a full professorship and/or the title of Professor Honoris within the University or an institute administered by a Faculty for a total of 10 (ten) years or more (with any extension of a professorship included when calculating this period) and must be deemed to have made a significant contribution to the University. The Board of the Faculty concerned shall make a recommendation to Senate by simple majority of those present for the conferment of the title on a retiring professor who meets the necessary conditions.
3. Where the full professor, or Professor Honoris, has held the position or positions (including any extension of a professorship) for a total of less than ten years prior to retirement, the title of Emeritus Professor may be conferred by special resolution of the Senate, in association with Council, following a Faculty Board recommendation on the basis of a two-thirds majority of members present.
4. Emeritus Professors will be accorded the privilege of using the library and sporting facilities, invitation to appropriate University functions and any other privileges which may be accorded by Council and the Faculty Board.
