

IMPLEMENTATION OF COUNCIL POLICY ON REMISSION OF FEES FOR FULL-TIME MASTERS AND DOCTORAL STUDENTS

The policy is being implemented with effect from this year and is applicable only to full-time postgraduates who are registering for the first time this year.

The remission is for three years for PhD students and one year for Research Masters students. Students unable to complete within the above periods will be charged fees for each subsequent year/semester until they complete. The chargeable fees will be in accordance with the structure indicated below. Should students who have received fee remission convert from full-time to part-time registration, there will be financial implications. The fees structure applicable will be finalised later this year, for implementation from 2010.
